Achaval Ferrer Finca Bella Vista It is distinguished by its smoothing features and finely meshed texture. It is elegant and aromatic with an endless finish and a juicy acidity that stands out. It is the most elegant expression of Malbec that you will find anywhere.

### VINIFICATION /WINEMAKING PROCESS

Aerated pump-overs with soft sprinkling of the cap, followed by pressing at the end of and up to 4 days after fermentation as determined by daily tasting results. No Itering. Cold soaks, acid correction, bleed-offs and addition of enzymes were not used during vinification.

## **FERMENTATION**

Fermented in cement tanks at a maximum temperature up to 93-95oF with extensive pumping over for better extraction.

#### MALOLACTIC

100% spontaneous in oak barrels.

#### OAK AND AGING

15 months in new (100%) French Oak Barrles



"Bright, moderately saturated medium ruby, Aromas of cassis, redcurrant, spices, herbs and tobacco along with an element of chocolatey oak. Wonderfully fine-grained, lively and sweet; both darker and brighter in its flavor profile than the Finca Altamira but also more open-knit today, showing a strong element of spicy oak. Finishes smooth, broad and sweet, but is it as complex? A second bottle of equal breadth was a bit more sharply focused and floral, and finished with a serious tannic spine and sneaky building persistence. This Malbec needs time."
